ORDER FOR INJUNCTION

(Assigned to Hon. Joshua D. Rogers)

Pursuant to the stipulation of the parties, and therefore good cause appearing,
IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that:

1. The Court finds that the parties published statements about one another at the following webpages that will cause the parties irreparable commercial harm if the webpages are not removed from the Internet or if the webpages continue to appear in Internet search engine results when Internet users search for the parties' names online:

2. The parties shall remove the above webpages or the statements they published via the

1 webpages from the Internet if they are able to remove them without obtaining approval
2 from any third person.

3 3. In the event the parties are unable to remove the webpages or the statements without
4 obtaining approval from a third person, the parties may submit this Order to Google, Bing,
5 Metacrawler, Yahoo!, Ask.com, Aol, Dogpile, and any other Internet search engine, so that
6 the applicable webpages can be removed, delisted, and de-indexed from all search engine
7 results in accordance with the policies of the search engine company.

8 4. This Order does not prohibit or restrain the parties from publishing any statements
9 they will make, state, or write on or after this Order's date.

10 5. This Court shall retain jurisdiction to the extent it is necessary to amend this Order,
11 except that if this case is dismissed, this order for injunction shall be treated as vacated and
12 set aside *ab initio*.
